The Philippine Educational Measurement and Evaluation Association (PEMEA) is pleased to invite you and your colleagues to the National Convention on Educational Measurement and Evaluation (NCEME) 2015. It will be held on September 25 to 26, 2015 at the Manila Grand Opera Hotel, Doroteo Jose, Manila.

The theme of this conference is "21st Century Student Assessment Across Levels and Disciplines". The conference aims for teacher educators, basic education teachers, test administrators and other education stakeholders to: (1) acquire knowledge and understanding of student assessment across levels and disciplines; (2) engage in a discussion on the different kinds of assessment in the 21st century; (3) share best practices related to classroom assessment; and (4) establish linkages with professionals in the field of measurement and evaluation. The convention will cover topics on assessing 21st century skills, K to 12 assessment framework, diagnostic, formative, summative, mother-tongue based, and outcomes-based assessment.

International and local measurement and assessment experts were invited to be the Resource Persons in this conference. DepEd and CHED endorsement for the convention will be made available.
